

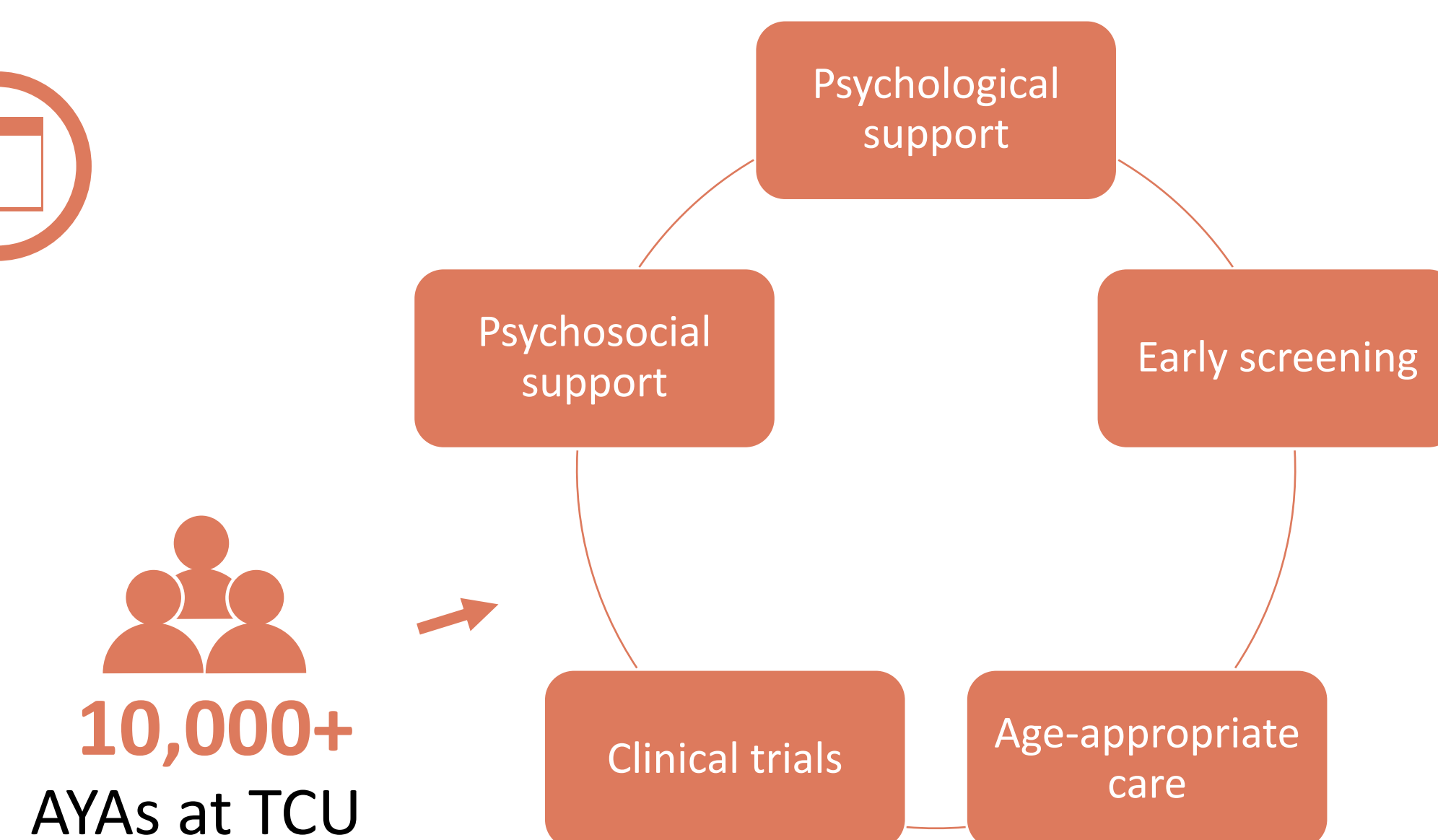
Introduction

Background

80K adolescents and young adults (AYAs) ages 15 to 39 **are diagnosed** with cancer in the US **every year**

in the last 30 Years

AYAs have had the least improvement in survival rates of any age group and for some diagnoses, there has been **NO** improvement

1 AYA diagnosed every 7 minutes:
8X MORE than pediatric diagnoses

Cancer **#1** disease-related cause of death in 15 to 39 year olds

AYAs are diagnosed each year in Tarrant County and the five surrounding counties

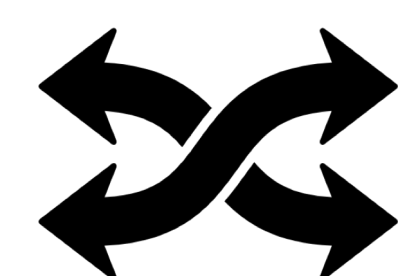
60% of patients under 18 are involved in potentially lifesaving clinical trials compared to **>5%** of patients over 18
